



We can't wait to see you for in-person services. As we prepare for your child's arrival in The Peak, here's what you can expect so you can enjoy a safe and engaging experience:

Before you arrive:

- Tickets will be required. Whether your child attends one of our family ministries or joins you in the auditorium, you must reserve a ticket for every child and adult in your party.
- Please stay home and watch online if you or your child does not feel well.

Check-in/check-out:

- Temperature checks will be required for all Peak children and volunteers upon arrival.
- Child check-in is now centrally located in the lobby.
- We ask that only one parent per child enters The Peak for drop-off and pickup.
- During pickup, if you have children in both Peak and KidSummit, we recommend picking up your KidSummit children first. You will exit the building from The Peak.

In The Peak:

- Volunteers will wear masks.
- Excluding the baby room, no outside food or drink is permitted. Bottles for infants should be premixed and labeled.
- Snack will no longer be part of our experience.
- All Peak rooms and toys will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected before and after every service.
