

We can't wait to see you for in-person services. As we prepare for your arrival, here's what you can expect so you can enjoy a safe and engaging worship experience:

Before you arrive:

- Tickets will be required. Whether attending The Peak, KidSummit, or the main service in the auditorium, you must reserve a seat for every child and adult in your party (including children who will attend the worship service with you).
- Please stay home and watch online if you do not feel well.

Check-in process:

- Plan to arrive 15 minutes before the service starts.
- Have your ticket confirmation ready upon arrival (either on your phone or printed out beforehand).
- Follow the driveway signs to check in at the appropriate tent in the parking lot.
- Temperature checks will be required for all children and volunteers going into The Peak or KidSummit.

In the building:

- All volunteers will wear masks.
- Guests who are elementary-aged and older are asked to wear a mask; masks will be available if you do not have one.
- Wash your hands or use hand sanitizer.
- Maintain physical distance.
- Seating is limited in each meeting space to help accommodate physical distancing guidelines.
- In the auditorium, seat spacers will provide two empty seats between families.
- 47 new hand sanitation stations have been added throughout the building.
- Touch-free sinks and toilets have been installed throughout the building.
- Each meeting space will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected before and after every service.
