



We can't wait to see you for in-person services. As we prepare for your child's arrival in KidSummit, here's what you can expect so you can enjoy a safe and engaging experience:

Before you arrive:

- Tickets will be required. Whether your child attends one of our family ministries or joins you in the auditorium, you must reserve a ticket for every child and adult in your party.
- Please stay home and watch online if you or your child does not feel well.

Check-in/check-out:

- The check-in process will begin at one of the three patio entrances.
- Please have your child's ticket ready upon arrival. Tickets for KidSummit will be checked on the patio.
- Temperature checks will be required at check-in for all KidSummit children and volunteers.
- We ask that only one parent per child enter the family ministry hallways for drop-off and pickup.
- KidSummit families can check in at either The Peak or KidSummit check-in areas.
- KidSummit will offer a touchless check-in and check-out process for families.
- Parents will pick up their children outside the theater exit door.

In KidSummit:

- Volunteers will wear masks.
- Children are asked to wear masks.
- Each child and volunteer will receive hand sanitizer before entering the KidSummit environment.
- Small group rooms will not be used at this time. All activities will instead take place in the large group area.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at each grade station.
- Each child will receive their own supplies for activities; items will not be shared among children.
- Seat markers placed throughout the environment will help children maintain physical distance.
- The KidSummit environment will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected before and after every service.
