

We can't wait to see you for in-person services. As we prepare for your arrival, here's what you can expect so you can enjoy a safe and engaging worship experience:

Before you arrive:

- Tickets will be required. Whether attending The Peak, KidSummit, or the main service in the auditorium, you must reserve a seat for every child and adult in your party (including children who will attend the worship service with you).
- Please stay home and watch online if you do not feel well.

Check-in process:

- Plan to arrive 15 minutes before the service starts.
- Have your ticket confirmation ready upon arrival (either on your phone or printed out beforehand). Tickets for family ministries will be checked on the patio. Tickets for the worship service will be checked at the auditorium doors.
- Temperature checks on the patio will be required for all children and volunteers going into The Peak or KidSummit.

In the building:

- All volunteers will wear masks.
- Guests who are elementary-aged and older are asked to wear a mask; masks will be available if you do not have one.
- Wash your hands or use hand sanitizer.
- Maintain physical distance.
- Seating is limited in each meeting space to help accommodate physical distancing guidelines.
- In the auditorium, seat spacers will provide two empty seats between families.
- Touchless experiences have been added throughout the building for additional safety.
- Each meeting space will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected before and after every service.
